Lower Extremity Special Tests Hip Special Tests § Trendelenburg Test: a test for weakness of the gluteus medius muscle during unilateral weight bearing Therapist is positioned behind patient to observe the pelvis The patient assumes a unilateral stance on the test side extremity

Upper Extremity Special Tests Cervical Tests § Vertebral Artery Test: used to test for vertebral artery occlusion or insufficiency The subject lies supine on the plinth with the examiner seated behind with both hands cupping and supporting the patient's head
